NOTICE OF RACE

SNIPE CLASS INTERNATIONAL RACING ASSOCIATION

COPPA ADRIACO SNIPE

Valid for the Adriatic Snipe Series
Trieste, April 27-28, 2019

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Yacht Club Adriaco, in co-operation with the Snipe Class International Racing Association

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) available at http://www.snipe.org/images/2018Rules/SCIRA_2018_Rules-of-Conduct-final.pdf
- 1.3 The RRS as modified by the Rules for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) as specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 The National Prescriptions.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year.
- 3.2 No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
 - they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.

4. FEES:

- 4.1. Entry fee € 50; registrations shall be made online at the following website by April 25, 2019.

- 4.2 Late registrations, after April 25, on site. Regatta office is open on Friday April 26 from 3.30 to 7.00 p.m., and on Saturday April 27 from 8.30 to 9.30 p.m.
- 4.3. Saturday evening "Pasta & Beer Party" for non-participants 15 €, to be paid on site.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Friday April 26 from 3.30 to 7.00 p.m.
- 5.2 Schedule of Races:
Saturday, April 27, 2019: warning signal first race at 12.00
- 5.3 No more than three (3) races shall be sailed per day. Six (6) races are scheduled. One (1) race must be completed to constitute the “Coppa Adriaco Snipe”.

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.2 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available on April 25, 2019

8. VENUE.

Races will be sailed in the Gulf of Trieste

9. COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses as published in the SCIRA Rulebook or web site.

10. SCORING:

- 10.1 The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
- 10.2. If 5 or fewer races are completed, all shall be counted. If 6 races are completed, the worst race shall be excluded, including a disqualification. In case of ties the RRS Appendix A will be applied.

11. SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register, within the limits specified in 5.1 above, to the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

12. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 13.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 PRIZE GIVING:

It will take place on Sunday April 28 at the Yacht Club Adriaco.

16. MEDIA RIGHTS

- 16.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the SCIRA, organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

Emblematic of: Snipe Regattas on the waters of the Gulf of Trieste, Istria and Dalmatian Coast (Italy and Croatia)

Open to: Snipe skippers and crews in good standing from anywhere in the world.

2019 Regattas:

- a) Coppa Adriaco Snipe – Trieste (YCA), April 27-28
- b) Sipar International – Moscenicka Draga (Croatia), May 25-26
- c) Pre-European Test Event – Split (Croatia), September 7-8

Regatta Conditions: The different series of race are to be arranged and agreed upon by officials of these clubs. “Rules for Conducting National and International Regattas” are specific instructions furnished by the International Rules Committee and approved by the SCIRA Board of Governors. These instructions must be followed in all respects.

Scoring: The series is formed by all the races of the 3 regattas chosen, considering all the skippers which sailed the series. Three races are required to constitute a series. The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
